


OVERHEAD REQUIREMENTS

The InfraDrive™ system is known for its compact and efficient design, allowing for more usable space within the home. By reducing the amount of space required for elevator equipment, you can maximize the overall living area of your home. The InfraDrive™hoistway overhead requirements for the top floor are:

- 6'8" Cab Height requires a minimum of 96" from top floor finished flooring to the lowest point of finished hoistway ceiling
- 7'4" Cab Height requires a minimum of 102" from top floor finished flooring to the lowest point of finished hoistway ceiling
- 8'0" Cab Height requires a minimum of 110" from top floor finished flooring to the lowest point of finished hoistway ceiling
