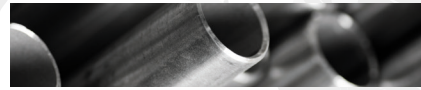

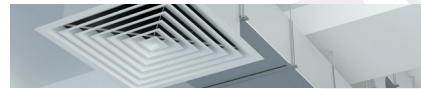
LARGEST exporting country in the world in marble and travertine.



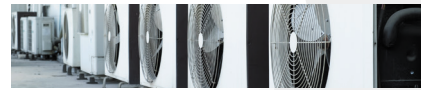
LARGEST exporting country in the world in rebar



LARGEST producing country in Europe and 4th in the world in (welded) steel pipe.



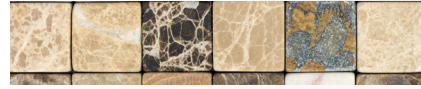
LARGEST producing country in Europe in field of flexible air ducts and vents.

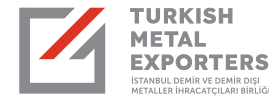

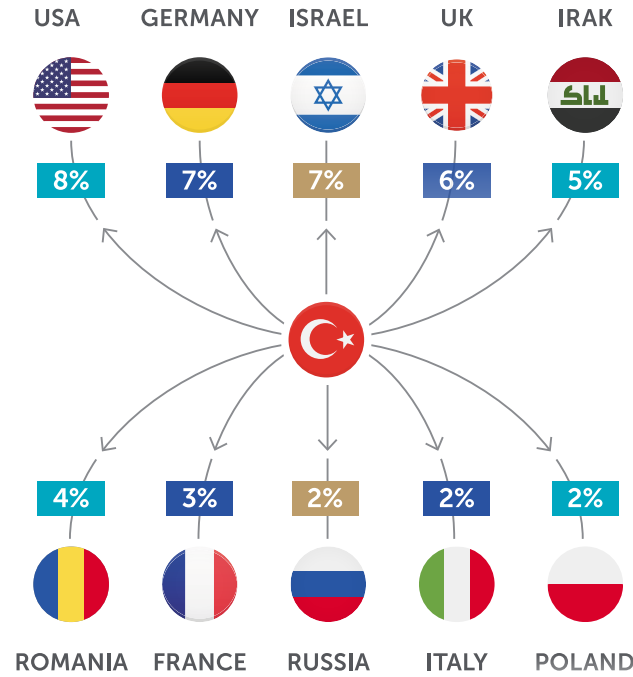

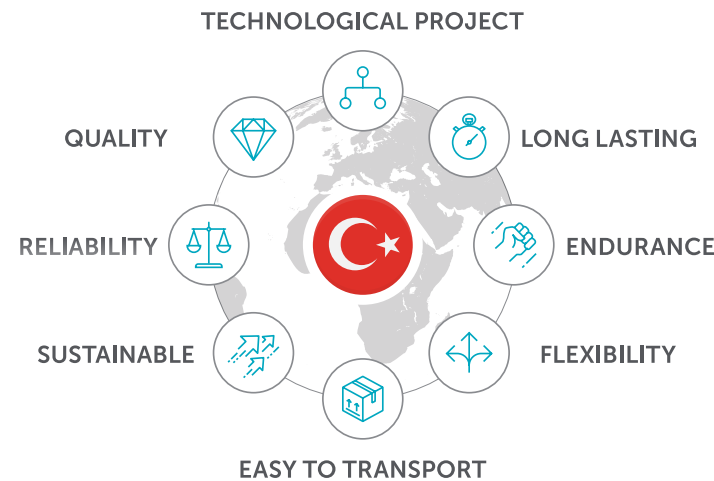

WHY TURKISH CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS



Construction Materials sector Export volume in 2022 have reached 1.3 Trillion USD its value. Turkish Construction Materials exports 36 Billion USD with a 3% share carried out throughout the process. During the process, 63% of the share of export were concentrated in European region, while 21% of it focused on the African continent. In 2022 Turkish Contracting services new projects volume reached 19,1 billion USD. 42 Turkish contracting companies are ranked among "The World's Top 250 International Contractors" list, published in February 2023 by the leading international industry magazine "ENR Engineering News Record".
